Westminster Community Pantry Update

WAYS TO SUPPORT THE WESTMINSTER COMMUNITY PANTRY:

If you would like to sign up to work our Westminster Community Pantry, Wednesday evenings, 4 to 7 p.m. or Thursday mornings, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Please see the sign-up sheets on the bulletin board outside the sanctuary. <u>MONETARY</u> <u>DONATIONS</u> are also appreciated. Every dollar donated to our Food Pantry buys up to 4 meals for our Pantry guests.

Michigan Sugar donated 500 two lb. bags of sugar; 100 bags will be used by Missions as the Thanksgiving committee prepares 100 Thanksgiving baskets to be distributed to Bay Country homes. The remaining sugar will be used in our Food Pantry.

You have been very generous to our Food Pantry guests. They are enjoying the butter you have donated for our **November ITEM OF THE MONTH**. Thank you! Donations of the November ITEM OF THE MONTH are still being accepted.

Our December ITEM OF THE MONTH is flour to help with holiday baking. We will need 2 or 5 pound bags which can be left on the cart outside the pantry door. This partners nicely with the brown and granulated sugar we have received from Monitor Sugar.

We are **hearing from several of our guests** that either they or their spouse have been laid off, and **they greatly appreciate** coming to our Westminster Community Pantry.
